Alabama Christian Academy was founded in 1942 by a small group of men who were committed to providing a Bible-based education for Montgomery's youth. In 1985, ACA moved to its present location and implemented a phased building program, which culminated with the addition of additional classrooms for both elementary and high school and the renovation of the football stadium.

Alabama Christian Academy is accredited by the Southern Association of Colleges and Schools (SACS) and is a member of the National Christian Schools Association (NCSA). In addition, ACA maintains membership in the Alabama High School Athletic Association.

Religious Affiliation

ACA is an independent Christian, college preparatory, coeducational school affiliated with the churches of Christ and operates under an independent board of directors. The Pre-Kindergarten through 12th grades are located on the same campus at 4700 Wares Ferry Road.
