

Electives

These electives will not satisfy requirements for core course work; however, “extra” core courses may be substituted for elective credit. A total of 26 credits are required for graduation. Offerings of electives may vary from year to year according to student demand, scheduling availability, and administrative discretion.

Ninth Grade

- **Band** – This may be taken in lieu of P.E. If your child is an athlete and must be in weight training, but they still want to participate in Band, this is his or her elective (tryout required).
- **Bible/Chorus** – Can be taken with your child’s Bible class (tryout required). This year we will be attempting to have a Beginner Chorus and an Advanced Chorus.
- **Yearbook** – Student must apply to the sponsor and be selected for this class. If your child plans to apply, you can list this as the elective, but make sure that you include alternatives, in case he or she is not selected.
- **Health/Computer Application** (you will see this listed as a 10th grade requirement, but it may be taken as an elective in the 9th grade which will free up another elective slot in the 10th grade).

10th Grade

- **Band** – (tryout required)

- **7:00 a.m. Bible** – May be taken in order for your child to free up an elective space (Designed for those students who are both an athlete and in the band or for those who are trying to squeeze in extra academic courses in order to receive an advanced diploma.)
- **Yearbook** – Student must apply to the sponsor and be selected for this class. If your child plans to apply, you can list this as the elective, but make sure that you include alternatives, in case he or she is not selected.
- **Shakespeare Survey** – May be taken in place of 10th grade English if the student made an “A” in 9th grade English and/or with recommendation of the 9th grade teacher.
